Dear Parents, guardians and well wishers,



REGISTRATION AND ADMISSION

The academic year is from April to March. The registration for admission for all the classes commence from January during working hours on payment of Rs. 1000/- as a registration fee. The prospectus and the admission form are supplied at the time of admission. The application for admission must be submitted with the prescribed form along with two passport size photographs.

A student will not be admitted without a transfer certificate granted from the school last attended and in no case a student shall be permitted to attend a class pending formal admission. In case of admission a written test is required for the class in which the admission is sought to be except Std-1.

The application form must accompany a Xerox copy of authenticated birth certificate granted by the municipality, or the government hospitals. The date of birth once recorded will not be changed in future. Five plus is the age of admission to Std. 1. A corresponding scale of age is fixed for the subsequent classes.

EXAMINATION

There are two term examinations. The first terminal exam is held in the month of September and the annual exam in the month of March. The Principal reserves the right to promote or detain any student. The decision of the Principal is final and binding.

- Besides these examinations unit tests on different subjects are conducted regularly in the classes.
- Students who fail in the same class for two consecutive years in succession will not be allowed to stay further.
 A transfer certificate will be issued to him/her after dues are cleared.
- The attendance in all the papers in both the examinations is compulsory to obtain rank in the examination
- No student is allowed to appear at the examination if the dues are not cleared.
- Admit Card is issued to each student to take the examination if there is no outstanding dues against him/her. A student is not allowed to enter the examination hall without Admit Card.
- 75% attendance is compulsory to take the examination.

PARENTS-TEACHER MEETING

In order to establish meaningful relationship between the school and the parents, PT meeting are held three times in a year to discuss the progress of each student.

Parents are always welcome to the school on working day between 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM to discuss the problems of their wards with the principal and the teacher concerned, with permission.

CHALLENGING AND EXPERIMENTAL EDUCATION

ATTENDANCE

Children should reach ten minutes before the assembly bell rings and leave home immediately after the school is over. Regular attendance is of great importance for the desired progress of the children. A written application for absence should be made in the prescribed page of the diary. In case of sudden illness or other unforeseen reasons an application should be given in a way of information and a letter must be given on the return of the child to school. If the illness continues for a long period a certificate of the attending physician stating the nature of illness and fitness to join the school must be attached to the leave application.

RULE OF DISCIPLINE

Children are expected to be well mannered, obedient, punctual, Smart, clean and neatly dressed Parents/guardians are expected to promote these habits in their children from beginning as these are the keys to success in life. Their full co-operation is essential in establishing good habits of punctuality, regularity and discipline. It is very much appreciated when parents respond readily to the invitation sent for specific reasons or to attend parent-teacher meetings and other School events. It is only with the Co-operation of the parents that school can promote all-around development of students.

In case of irregular attendance, idleness, negligence in homework, disobedience towards teacher and bad influence inside or outside the school will justly be the cause of the removal of the children.



WITHDRAWAL OF CHILDREN

Parents / Guardians must apply for withdrawal of their wards before the date of withdrawal and clear all the dues with the current fee before the T.C. is issued. The children after the completion of their studies get a usual school leaving certificate to enable themselves to take admission elsewhere, Note: Any change in the Rules and Regulations of the school or in Tuition fee besides any other changes will be binding on parents or guardians.

RULES IN GENERAL

- 1. Students should reach on time.
- 2. No student who is absent from school or is late (more than two times in a month) will be admitted into the class without the signed permission of the principal.
- 3. Care must be taken to observe the "Green Rules" in order to maintain clean, green surroundings.
- 4. That is the school campus must not be littered with disposal materials
- 5. No student is allowed to visit any of the chaos situated outside the school and if found doing so, he/she will be subjected to punishment.
- 6. Students are required to maintain discipline in school and in the bus.
- 7. Smoking, chewing gum, betel-nut or tobacco products etc. is strictly forbidden. Disobedience, bad conduct, stealing, any form of verbal or written obscenity, unfair means in examination Or sickness liable to be injurious to other boys Justify dismissal.
- 8. It is necessary to give notice to the parents of erring students before suspension is ordered. However, suspension shall be followed by an enquiry and the parents informed. It is mandatory for all students to speak only English in the school campus.

FEES

The fees are payable in advance and must be paid by 10th of every month in which they fall due. After that a fine of Rs. 100/- will be charged for every subsequent day.

A student who fails to pay fees up to date will not be allowed to appear at the examination. If there is a revision of fees due to rise in administrative expenses during the session or pay to the revised rate. Fees can be paid by cash/ cheque in favour of "NEW ERA PUBLIC SCHOOL, PATNA". The students of all the classes must clear all the dues up to March by 28th February.
